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# Musculokeletal Conditions in Canada





### MSK Conditions are the leading cause of disability around the globe

**11 million+** Suffer from MSK conditions every year **1 in 8** Canadians diagnosed with chronic back pain

### 47%

of employees said that their chronic condition and/or chronic pain missed work 85%

of workers will suffer back pain in their lifetime 72.9% of chronic pain sufferers say that pain interferes with work

# Economic Impact of MSK Conditions in Canada





Economic Impact

- A third of all lost time at work is due to MSK issues.
- Absenteeism costs Canadian organizations an average of 2.4% of gross payroll.
- 85% of people with back pain take less than 7 days off, but the remainder – 15% - are absent for over a month.
- The average rate of absence (FT employees) due to illness or disability is **8.1 days**.

# **Employers estimated that 34% of their workforce had a chronic condition**




#### Reality,

- Sixty per cent of employees reported having been diagnosed with at least one chronic condition.
- Almost three out of four employees live with a chronic condition and/or chronic pain

The reality of chronic disease and chronic pain 45-48% of members reported chronic pain. Chronic pain is more likely for plan members who:

- have arthritis (82%)
- a mental-health condition (61%)
- lung disease
   (60%)
- high levels of stress
   (59%)









### COVID-19 and chronic Pain

51% of employers anticipate MSK health issues in the year ahead, due to:

- Poor ergonomic workspaces
- Declining mental health
- Decreased physical fitness





# Paramedical and Chiropractic Care







### Role of **Chiropractic** Care



The goals of care are:

- **Pain and symptom** management
  - **Improve function**
- **Decrease** risk or reoccurrence, chronicity and disability

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Value of Early Intervention

- Reduce sick leave and lost work productivity among workers with MSK by more than 50%
- Reduce the risk of permanent work disability and job loss by up to 50%
- Reduce the risk of developing a concurrent conditions

   (i.e., depression)







### Improving Value

### **Chiropractic:**

- Lowers short & long term disability risk
- Increases return to work and productivity
- ✓ Lowers pharmaceutical costs
- ✓ Supports mental health
- ✓ Lowers treatment costs
- ✓ Increases patient satisfaction
- Encourages patients to manage their health to prevent onset of MSK conditions
