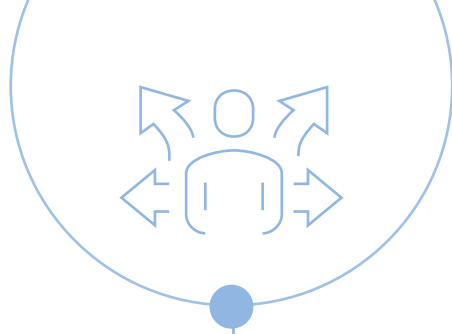

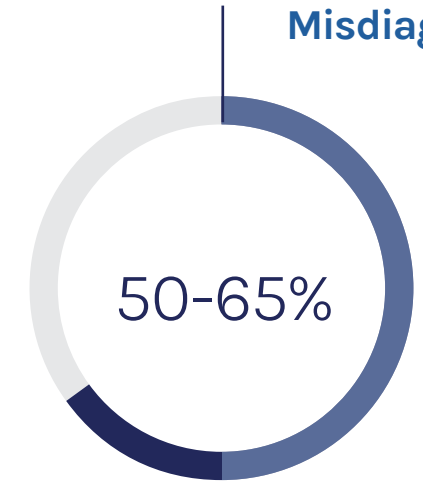

- Minimizing delays

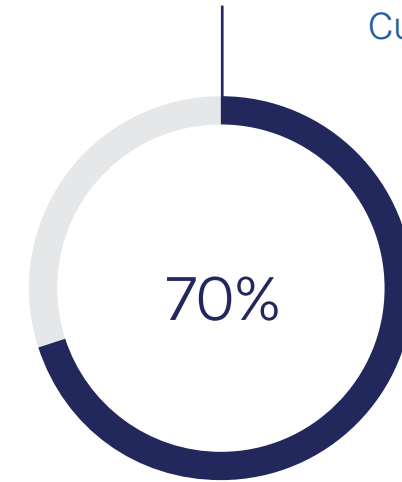
Early, **effective psychiatric treatment** has been associated with:

70% of patients don't respond to their first treatment. 30% still won't after their fourth.



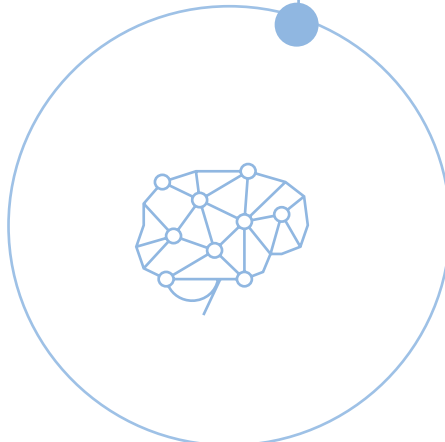
Organizations who **support mental health and well-being** are making significant efforts to improve employee health.

How it works?

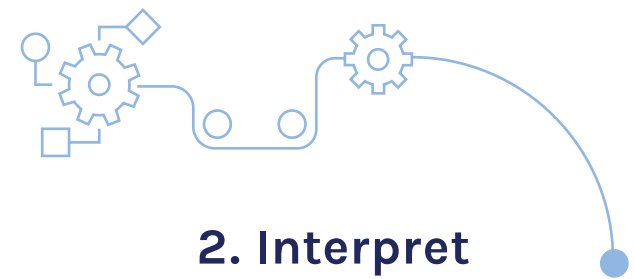
1. Collect

Information collected from existing medical documentation; missing information gathered from patient or employee.



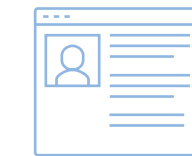
2. Interpret
